On Friday June 15th an application of algaecide/herbicide was applied to Lake A/C. Twenty-four hours later an application of colorant was added.

The purpose of these applications is to reduce the amount of vegetation in the water and then dye the water to minimize the amount of UV rays penetrating the lake waters causing vegetation / algae to grow.

The chemicals that were applied are the same chemicals that were applied to Lake A/C prior to the spillway rebuild and have been used on Lake D for over 10 years. Prior to this application, there has never been a detrimental effect to the fish in the lakes.

Larry Jordan, our Property Manager at Crye Leike spoke with Jeff Buler at West TN Pond Management late yesterday afternoon about the Lake A/C situation and he stated that there are many factors that played into the partial turnover that the lake experienced. The addition of the chemicals contributed to it but did not cause it.

The CWL Board is engaging a company to remove as many of the dead fish from Lake A/C as possible. This work is to begin immediately. We apologize for the inconvenience that this may cause those people surrounding the lakes. Hopefully this situation will be taken care of soon and we can begin enjoying our lakes again!
