### **City Engineer**

Lakeland, Tennessee: 9/07 to Present

I am currently assigned as the City Engineer for the City of Lakeland, Tennessee, a community of approximately 11,000 residents. I oversee a staff of one engineer and three employees in the Sewer Department. I report directly to the City Manager. The City currently is working on four capital projects worth nearly \$15 million. They include New Canada Road Realignment, the Canada Road Bike and Ped Pathway, the new Senior Center, and a small sewer project.

### **Public Services Director**

Casper, Wyoming: 2/93 to 9/07

I was assigned as the Public Services Director for the City of Casper, Wyoming, a community with approximately 55,000 residents for nearly 15 years. The Public Services Department consisted of six divisions: Engineering, Streets, Water and Sewer, Parks, Engineering, Solid Waste, Streets, and Fleet Maintenance. I reported directly to the City Manager.

My position included managing and administering the Public Services Department which included handling personnel matters, public relations, department staffing, safety programs, budgetary, capital planning, design and construction. The Public Services Department consisted of 14 work sections comprised of 220 full time and seasonal employees. The Department budget consisted of 16 costs centers of which 6 of them were enterprise funds (2 funds for water, 2 funds for sewer and 2 funds for sanitation). The operational budget for the Department was approximately \$35 million per year with an annual capital budget of nearly \$10 million.

### **City Engineer**

Casper, Wyoming 4/86 to 2/93

I was assigned as City Engineer for the City of Casper, Wyoming for 7 years. The City Engineer was in charge of the Engineering, Traffic, and Building Inspection Offices and capital planning, design and construction. The three offices employed 14 employees with a budget of nearly \$1,100,000. The City Engineer reported directly to the City Manager.
